

Terrain: 'Jura plateau'-style forest with plateau and steep flanks. Some areas with fine contour detail. Some parts very runnable with a dense network of paths, others with reduced visibility and runnability.

15 minutes walk to start, finish at event centre

Terrain: 'Jura plateau'-style forest with plateau, steep slopes to the Aare valley and the north.



Day 3

Sunday, 18th August 2019, urban sprint


Map Brugg, updated 2018, 1:5,000

Start list with start times from 10:00 Uhr

25 minutes walk to start/finish

Course planner: Arno Schneider, controller: P. Dauwalder

Terrain: partially in residential areas with houses, blocks of flats, playgrounds, small parks and little traffic, partially in the traffic-free old town of Brugg.



Overall results

The results of each day will be converted into points and added together for the overall results. The winner of each day receives 1000 points (no discarded days).

Aargau School and Youth Championship (ASJM)

Overprinted maps

The courses are overprinted for all day and classes. Open sCOOL and D/H10 with an overprinted route suggestion

Timing

The electronic timing and control system SPORTident is used for all days (SPORTident Air+ active)

SI cards can be borrowed each day free of charge.



Classes

According to standard competition rules:

Women: D10 / D12 / D14 / D16 / D18 / D18K / DAK / DAM / DAL / DB / D35 / D40 / D45 / D50 / D55 / D60 / D65 / D70 / D75

Men: H10 / H12 / H14 / H16 / H18 / H18K / HAK / HAM / HAL / HB / H35 / H40 / H45 / H50 / H55 / H60 / H65 / H70 / H75 / H80

(K = short)

Open courses: OS (open sCOOL): simple beginners course with navigation aids, for children born 2005 or later. Accompanying adults allowed.

OK (open short): suitable for beginners, groups

OM (open middle) / OL (open long): for the technically experienced and groups

S+E (she & he): medium difficulty

FAM (family): at least one adult and one child

Entry fees

All standard classes and open courses:

Born 1998 and older: CHF 24 per day

Born. 2002–1999: CHF 16 per day


Born 2003 and younger: CHF 10.- per day

S+E: CHF 24.- per day

FAM (family): free on Saturday – offered by Family O Day
